





ORDER

Petitioner has filed a motion to remand this case to the circuit court for a ruling on his timely motion to relieve counsel and motion to alter or amend the order of dismissal pursuant to Rule 59(e), SCRCP. The motion is granted. *See Hudson v. Hudson*, 290 S.C. 215, 216; 349 S.E.2d 341 (1986); *see also Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010). The notice of appeal is hereby dismissed without prejudice and either party can appeal within ten days after the order disposing of the post-trial motions is filed. *Id.*
