



Administration of Justice (means) Performance of acts or duties required by law in discharge of duty Rosner v. U.S. C.A. 2(NY) 1926, 10 F.2d 676, see also Cohan DC, Conn 1962, 222 Fed. Supp. 587.

The word due Administration of Justice impart a free and fair opportunity to every litigant in a pending case cause in a federal court to learn concerning material facts and to exercise his option as to introducing testimony as to such facts, Wilder v. U.S. C.A. 4 (W. VA) 1906, 143 F. 933, 74 C.C.A. 867, cert denied 27 Oct. 787, 204 US, 679 S. 1ed 674.
