where the court had no right to act.

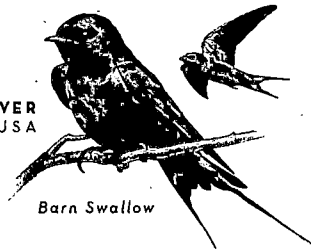
