Dear Clerk,


I manage to borrow a few sheets of paper. I drew this up in a short but to the point. I hope this is satisfactory for the Court.

I do thank you for your help.

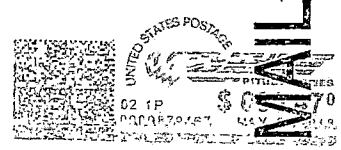
