NOTICE AND MOTION TO SET BOND

- 2.) Additionally, prior to the hearing of this matter the Defendant was released on Bond and did comply with all Orders of the Court regarding his appearance and he did in fact appear for his trial.
- 3.) The Appellant further contends that he was not properly notified that his probation

term had been extended, which subsequently resulted in the revocation on April 13, 2018. This improper notification amounted to a denial of the Appellant's due process rights, and he should be allowed to be out on bond pending any appeal.

- 4). That if released on Bond, the Appellant will take residence at his home in Richland County, South Carolina.






