
When she finally answered, I informed her of the above case of which she apologized, but she was at home and was not feeling well. I then informed her that I was still waiting for her response to my email requesting the transcript, of which I attached in my documents to your Court. She informed me that she can't recall but she does not remember who told her NOT to transcribe and that she was only hired to make an appearance and record. Second, the Court Hearing Officer, Ralph Stroman, informed us in Court that I would receive a copy of the transcript. Mrs. Burton indicated that she does not recall that conversation.

She informed me that currently, she has other cases ahead of this case and was not sure how long it may take to transcribe.

As of May 1, 2018, I attempted to contact her once again and her business phone is inoperable. I also went by her Office and no one was there for several hours without a notification posted on her business as to how long she may be out. Therefore, I am at an impasse as to the direction to proceed. Each attorney that I am currently trying to retain, would like to have it to review in order to file the appropriate document for requesting a Stay of the Writ of Ejectment from the Sheriff Office on May 9, 2018.

I understand that in order for the Court of Appeals to review any concerns, a Motion will have to be filed for the Court to make a determination to stay or vacate. In the process of consulting counsel, but it's difficult because I don't have the transcript as a reference to give them.

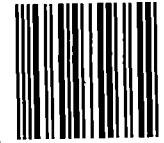
