MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days until June 11, 2018**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in the case of Micahel Livingston v. State with this Court on March 27, 2018. 5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




