Dear Clerk:

I am forwarding this letter to provide the status of what is happening in the trial court. On Wednesday, May 2, 2012, I had a telephone conversation with Attorney Edward S. McCallum III (Respondent/Defendant Norman's attorney) in regards to the actions taken by the circuit court. This telephone conversation was precipitated by Attorney McCallum calling my home on two separate occasions and leaving me a voice message (April 30 & May 1, 2012).

I was not home when attorney McCallum called and left these messages. On the first message attorney McCallum stated he was attempting to contact me at the request of the court and asked me to return the call to him. On the second message attorney McCallum informed me that the hearing scheduled for May 7 had been continued. When I called attorney McCallum on May 3, 2012 I asked what hearing was he informing me about because I had not received any notice about a hearing being scheduled for May 7, 2012. Attorney McCallum indicated it did not matter because the hearing had been continued. Attorney McCallum did not tell me when a new hearing is scheduled to take place. Attorney McCallum told me that the clerk of court had informed him that she had mailed me a notice about the hearing scheduled for May 7, 2012.

When I phoned (864 -942-8551) the circuit court on Wednesday, May 2, 2012, and asked to speak with Leah the clerk answering the phone told me Leah was out with a sick child and that she would take a message to have Leah return my call. The clerk answering the phone also stated Leah was handling this case and she would provide me with information. Attorney McCallum had indicated in one of his message that I should contact Leah.

I have requested attorney McCallum to mail me a copy of the notice of the hearing initially scheduled for May 7, 2012. As of this point in time I have not received a copy of that notice. I have not received a return call from Leah, the court clerk handling this case. I have not been informed why the hearing was continued or when a new hearing is

scheduled to convene. I do think it is unfair to schedule a hearing and only give me two or three days to report for the hearing. As soon as I know when another hearing is scheduled on my motion for reconsideration, I shall notify the court.
