RECORD ON APPEAL**





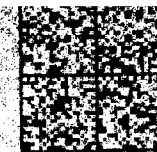
