

ORDER

The State filed a notice of appeal from a pretrial ruling of the circuit court issued on March 21, 2018. The proof of service shows service of the notice of appeal on April 23, 2018. Because the notice of appeal was not timely served, this appeal is dismissed. *See State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 784 S.E.2d 690 (Ct. App. 2016) (finding this Court does not have jurisdiction in the absence of a timely served notice of appeal); Rule 203(b)(2), SCACR (providing a notice of appeal from the court of general sessions must be served on all respondents within ten days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment). The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
