MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for William Ricky Welch respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until June 18, 2018**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.

2. Counsel for William Ricky Welch respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel had oral arguments before this Court in the case of State v. Lamar Sequan Brown on March 28, 2018. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Kenneth Jowan Craig v. State with this Court on March 19, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Micah A. Bilton with the Court of Appeals on March 19, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. David Richard Walker, Jr. with the Court of Appeals on March 19, 2018. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of State v. Gerald R. Williams with the Court of Appeals on March 13, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




