I am responding to the Court's request for a status update
dated December 11, 2012.

I have spoken counsel for Deertrack Golf, Mary Shahid, who
informs me that the applicant is preparing to address most of the
administrative deficiencies identified on remand. Counsel has
had some difficulty finding a qualified individual to work on
those deficiencies, which has delayed progress in responding to
the Respondent S.C. Department of Health and Environmental
Control's letter dated May 18, 2012, which set forth the terms of
the remand and requested additional information and required
additional steps to allow the agency to complete the required
agency action.

I will continue to maintain contact with counsel for both
Respondent DHEC and Deertrack Golf, Inc., in an effort to
address these issues.
