1) The clerk of court decision to dismiss the petitioners case on the grounds that a request for a ~~rehearing~~ rehearing of the in forma pauperis motion will not be entertained pursuant to rule 240(c) SCAIC is a misstatement of fact and law because the petitioner never requested a rehearing in his petition as provided by Rule 240(c) S.C.A.C.R. concerning the clerk's April 13th 2018 order denying in forma pauperis status in this appeal.
