Upon reviewing your respondent's initial brief, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your brief will not be considered:

- The brief exceeds the page limits permitted by Rule 208(b)(5), SCACR. The initial brief may not exceed 50 pages.
- The document is not paginated. Specifically, the document must be consecutively paginated.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, it must be called the Respondent's Initial Brief.
- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal. Pursuant to Rule 209, SCACR, the designation of matter must be set forth with specificity that which the party proposes to be included in the record on appeal. Please see Form 14 in Part II, Appendix C for an example of the required format for this document.
- We are returning your filing to you as unacceptable.

- If you would like for your respondent's initial brief and designation of matter to be considered, they must comply with Rules 208, 209 and 267, SCACR.
