## ORDER

By order dated February 12, 2018, the South Carolina Court of Appeals denied the petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the post-conviction relief (PCR) court. The Court of Appeals subsequently denied a petition for rehearing. Petitioner now asks for a thirty day extension to file the petition for a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the Court of Appeals.

In *Ellison v. State*, 382 S.C. 189, 676 S.E.2d 671 (2009), this Court determined that it will no longer entertain a petition for writ of certiorari where the Court of Appeals has denied a petition for a writ of certiorari in a PCR case. Therefore, no petition for a writ of certiorari can be filed in this case, and the motion for an extension is denied.
