I'm enclosing all that you ask to the best of my ability. Staff has 45 days to respond to a request to staff. So I wrote to the law librarian to have the indigency form notarized but she has 45 days to respond. So I hope what I provide is sufficient. I'm involuntarily committed to the mental hospital Gilliam Psychiatric Hospital so my movements and access to things are limited. Also pursuant to 44-22-30 I will be requesting for the appointment of an attorney. I thought in my first appeal case No: 2016-001606 the time was stayed until the circuit judge made a ruling on my 59(e) motion which I properly filed. Law states the judge had 10 days to alter or amend judgment but it took the judge nearly 2 years. I thought I could file a motion to reinstate and be covered from the first filing fee. I'm confused as to how the trial judges delays falls on my shoulders. I think once I consult with an attorney i'll have a better understanding. But i'm trying all I can to comply with court rules, but i'm limited. So I hope me being a mental health lay man is taken into consideration. I can only do so much with my limited understanding. You said in your letter dated 5-14-18 and 5-15-18 if I had any questions to call. I can't use the phone so I write. Can you shed some light on this matter.
