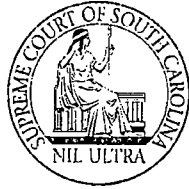

Dear Mr. Perry:

I have received your request from the Office of SC Court Administration for the Transcript of Record in the above-referenced case. Such transcripts cost \$3.25 per page. I have checked my records and have estimated that this record is approximately 11 pages at \$3.25 per page, for a total cost of \$35.75.

I see from your address that you are an inmate in the Department of Corrections. Please note that court reporters are not required by State or Federal law to provide free transcripts. It is also my understanding that no State agency is required to provide free transcripts, so I am not able to refer you to any other source.

Upon receipt of your certified check or money order (no personal checks) in the amount of \$35.75, I will forward the transcript to you. I am given 60 days in which to prepare the record. Extensions of time may be granted if necessary. My 60 days will not commence until receipt of payment.

Dear Mr. Perry:

I received your follow-up letter regarding the cost of your transcript. As an Official Court Reporter, there are certain requirements I must adhere to in preparing a Transcript of Record. There are three pages that are mandatory for every record: A title page, a certificate page, and an index page, after which I must transcribe the proceedings.

While I may be off by a page or two, I also have to consider the mailing costs. Besides, if I overestimate, I certainly refund any overage that may be due. I can't just pick a line or two out of the official record and prepare that and certify it as a true, complete, and accurate record that can be used for proof purposes.

So upon receipt of your certified check or money order in the amount of \$35.75, I will prepare this transcript for you. Maybe you could check the final order of the court to see what the judge ruled if there is any question about what transpired.
