
As a Prose' I know enough about the South Carolina legal system to take on four (4) big companies represented by two (2) experienced attorneys, but too stupid to take the time needed to pick up my Certified Mail of the transcript, for which I need for the South Carolina Court of Appeals to make an informed decision regarding my Appeal. The transcript is now public information, and if not received by the allotted time, I will be soliciting the aid of various Civil Rights Organizations, including, but not limited to the AMERICAN CIVIL LIBERTIES UNION, to request a copy of the Transcript.

I am aware that the ACLU is now suing Lexington County for, which is jailing mostly poor blacks that cannot afford to pay immediate court fines, happens in Sumter County almost on a daily basis, and sometimes with the aid of the Sumter County Clerk of Court. I was told that the Sumter County Clerk of Court send many Blacks back to jail by signing inmate's petitions before they can have their hearing before a judge, thereby sending them back to jail with no hearing.

With this kind of abuse in the Sumter County Legal System (if true), why would anyone think they would send me a transcript of a court session that will shine the light on Attorney's purposely making false statements, and a Judge altering the facts and evidence, so that the law doesn't fit.
