Dear Mr. Anderson:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- A proof of service showing that a copy of the notice of appeal has been timely served on the Workers' Compensation Commission has not been provided as required by Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR.
- The copies of emails that were filed along with your notice of appeal will not be accepted as part of the notice of appeal. Therefore, they are being returned to you.

- The notice of appeal must comply in form and content with Rule 203 of the SCACR. No argument is allowed in the notice of appeal.
- You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal substantially in the format shown by Form 6 in Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
