I recently filed motion for discretionary review by the Supreme Court of South Carolina. Due to lack of knowledge of South Carolina Appellant Court rules I failed to attach copy of order to petition. The fact that I am currently incarcerated in Federal Prison is an impediment making it difficult to meet requirements of state court proceedings due to limited access to S.C. State law. Only thru correspondence with friends and family did I find out the requirement to attach copy of order. From the beginning of my filing upon discovery of illegality of conviction and sentence, after filing amended version of case no. 2015-26-CP-1741 a request for advocacy was made for enablement of adequate filing addressing issue in full. Overwhelming evidence exists of the fact that on 10/21/2008 I was denied due process. Notice I based claims on federal court cases state court law is very limited again I ask this court to consider appointment of counsel to adequately address issue



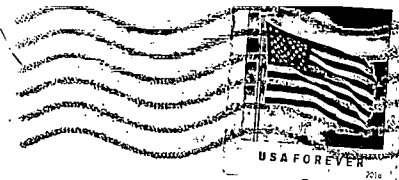
