

Please be advised that transcript fees are promulgated by SCACR Rule 607, which can be found at the following link:

I estimate that the transcript will consist of approximately 80 pages. Therefore, I will require an advance deposit of \$250.00 to place your request in line for transcription, sent to me at the address listed below. If the final cost exceeds this amount, I will contact you for additional payment before the transcript is finalized. Similarly, if the final cost is less than the deposit amount, I will refund the overage to you.

It is my understanding that you are not seeking expedited turnaround; therefore, normal time for delivery will be 60 days from the date of receipt of your payment.

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In accordance with the court reporter manual approved by the Supreme Court of South Carolina, the due date will be determined by the date I receive your advance payment.

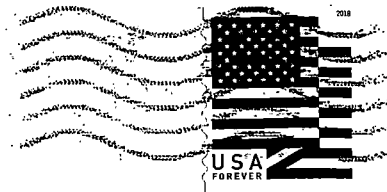
