For this motion to be considered by the Court, it will be necessary for you to provide this Court with the following by January 17, 2013:


- (1) The \$25 filing fee required by Rule 240(d), SCACR.¹

¹ Contrary to your assertion, this case does not involve a certified question of law under Rule 244, SCACR. Certified questions under that rule may only be submitted by a "federal court of the United States or the highest appellate court or an intermediate appellate court of any other state"

(2) Six copies of the motion as required by Rule 240(d), SCACR.

If you do not provide these items within the time specified, the motion may be treated as being abandoned and the remittitur may be sent. Rule 240(g), SCACR (failure of moving party to comply with requirements of this rule may be deemed an abandonment of the motion).
