RULING

Whereas, the case of Henderson v. Henderson has come before this court today, June 8, 2018, for a Bond Hearing, pursuant to the Order by the Circuit Court. I find the following.


A Bond Hearing was set for June 8, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. and both parties were summoned to court in writing by this court, and were served with this notice by the Constable Bobby Davis on May 31, 2018, in person and a copy was served by mail.

At the time of the Bond Hearing, the Plaintiff, Kim Henderson was present and the court waited until 10:40 a.m. for the Defendant Lakessiah Henderson to appear, per her summons; and she failed to appear as requested by this court. There has been no contact by Lakessiah Henderson to this court about her absence or reason for her failure to appear nor request a continuance. At the time of the Bond Hearing, the Constable testified that Defendant was served in person.

Due to Lakessiah Henderson's failure to appear as summoned, failure to notify court, failure to vacate the premises and failure to post bond, it is the opinion of this court that Lakessiah Henderson is in violation of this Court's Order and the Order from the Circuit Court, and therefore has forfeited her rights to stay the execution of the WRIT of Ejection.

Upon notification of the higher court that the stay has been lifted, our Constable will serve a WRIT of Ejection upon the Defendant and move to uphold the original ruling and if the Defendant does not vacate the premises as ordered, Local Law Enforcement will move to execute removal of Defendant from the premises at 3 Welcome Ave, Greenville, S.C. 29611.
