Inmates carried the Victim to Medical. Since that day Affiant has not seen that victim however, continued to discuss the ongoing violence with the victim's roommate, old man and others about this particular incident and other numerous episodes of violence and criminal activity, that was reported. If interested to Reader, other detailed information is available.

21) On another occasion, on a Saturday three inmates attacked a inmate allegedly because "he did not get along with his roommate and the inmate "power that be" wanted him out of the unit. The three knocked this victim to the ground a he faught all three. Once the Third Victim hit the concrete floor on his back, inmate Beaver 10 kicked the victim. As patterned daily, no SCDC guard was on the wing. The victim reported the Assault and Battery by Mob but was not movd to another Unit until the following week.

22) Another fight ensued between this victim and racially special inmate eadr, Dar ^(See Supplement) Smith. As with i/m Smith and the other special picked inmates by Ms T. Jenkins, etc these inmates would continuously engage in repeated violent acts and criminal activity without any discipline, recourse or accountability.

23) The same week, i/m leader, AKA "Coordinator" D. Smith bullied, provoked and picked a fight with several residents, in particular, ^{See Supplement} Younger, a native to the area that began in the coordinator room, # that continued on the rock area whil an i/m upstairs recorded the fight with his illegal Boast Mobile cellur phone. At one point, I/M Younger snatched Smith's pants to his knees. I/M Younger and Smith knocked over a floor plant during their fight hat Affiant that Affiant helped clean up because it was around Affiant's assigned room 4.

24) As common, when this particular fight was brought to Ms Jenkins attention several times by multiple residents she "shoed" Affiant and other residents way. Jenkins told inmates to mind their business, totally ignored some inmates and playd along with others as if she would do something about it or specifically discipline or replace "Leader Smith", but did not. I/M Younger was moved from c.B B #26 to Room 8 on c.B.

25) on another occasion, i/m leader "Dy" entered i/m "spider's" assigned Room # ^{See Supplement} upstairs during a count, on a Saturday while SCDC Sgt Ms Woods stood outside the door of Spider's room and took no action. Supervisor Woods talked smack and threatened spider. I/M Dy shut spider's door and attacked the victim. Affiant heard the two fighting and spoke with assailants first hand afterwards.

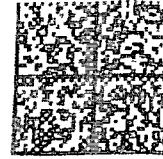

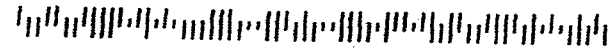

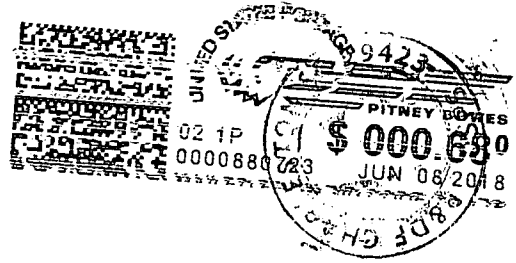
