**MOTION FOR VARIANCE BECAUSE OF ECONOMIC HARDSHIP
AND ENLARGE TIME BECAUSE OF INSUFFICIENT NOTICE**

The Clerk sent a notice stating that the appellant had 10 days to respond. The notice was dated for May 31 and the appellant did not receive it until June 8. In response to the clerk, the appellant requires more time to respond.

The appellant had previously requested a variance from the rules requiring her brief to be bound and duplicated in a certain format, and it was unreasonably expensive and would have created an economic hardship for the appellant. It appears that the court accepted this motion, but now the clerk is again asking the appellant to make similar changes to the briefs she has already filed, once again, creating a substantial economic hardship.

The appellant once again asks this court to review her brief and the issues on appeal, solely on their merits. The documents filed by the appellant are legible and the best she can possibly provide given her economic situation.

Requiring the appellant to create an additional brief is costly and would again create an economic burden. No prejudice to the appellee would result from allowing the appellant's appeal to be heard on its merits. There is no reason to delay justice because the pages of the brief are not formatted or duplicated in some kind of special

way, especially in view of the court's ability to use computers to duplicate the documents it needs instead of wasting more paper and making redundant pages of the same information.

The appellant is asking for the court to review the brief as it is, on the merits, it's the reason people created the court system in the first place.

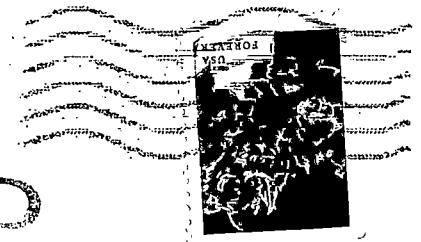
