
REPLY TO RETURN TO

SERVE AND FILE APPELLANTS' INITIAL REPLY BRIEF AND
DESIGNATION OF MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN APPEAL

Respondent has filed a "limited opposition" return to Appellants' motion for extension (Ret. at 1) to file their initial reply brief and designation, seeking assurances that undersigned counsel will "work to ensure that no further extensions are necessary." (Ret. at 3).

Undersigned counsel's recovery from his second knee surgery in five months has progressed much more swiftly than the nine-week recovery required for the recovery from the first surgery. He recently returned to work after being able to stop using prescription pain killers – he works at home due to his home healthcare physical therapy schedule, but he is confident that he will be able to serve and file Appellants' initial reply brief by July 5, 2018, and that no further extensions will be necessary.




