This responds to your petition for rehearing. This petition was received by this Court on December 27, 2012, in an envelope post-marked December 20, 2012. No action will be taken on this petition for several reasons.

First, this matter was dismissed by order dated November 30, 2012. Accordingly, under Rule 221, SCACR, any petition for rehearing had to be *actually received* by this Court on or before December 17, 2012. Therefore, the petition is untimely.

Second, when no petition for rehearing was received by this Court within the time specified by Rule 221, the remittitur was sent to the lower court on December 21, 2012. The sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case.
