ORDER


On October 10, 2012, this court affirmed the order of the Appellate Panel of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission (Appellate Panel) finding Appellant Virginia Miles failed to prove her alleged injuries arose out of and in the course and scope of her employment. On October 24, 2012, Miles filed a petition for rehearing and a motion to supplement the record. On November, 5, 2012, Respondents filed a return to the motion to supplement the record, objecting to the supplementation of the record after the issuance of the opinion.
