
I have received your letter of June 4, 2018, and the Court's request for a Memorandum regarding the appealability of this matter in its current posture. After conducting further review and research, and after a prior conversation with opposing counsel, it is Appellant's concession that an appeal of the current orders may be inappropriate at this juncture and/or interlocutory.
