Motion Request to Correct Error by SC Appeals Court and Revisit Submission, received, dated March 26, 2018, see attached for reference.

Whereas the court made a serious error in its decision to state counsel requested to be relieved of Appellant Case. This correction is necessary for the fact of the corporation request the removal of counsel be in the record and the record should reveal the facts.

It is also requested as to why none of the issues in the Motion which is attached were addressed by the South Carolina Appeals Court for the travesty of justice against us? That motion clearly outlines and request the SC Appeal Court vacate the lower court ruling an order a new case at least. At best the Court should vacate lower court ruling and refer case for formal criminal investigation to Beth Warren' Office, into fraud and criminal charges against United States Trustee Linda Barr, South Carolina Community Bank and Richardson and Plowden Law Firm and conspiracy by Robert Cooper and Robert Pohl for suppression of evidence against the Court and justice.


