The final brief must be identical to Appellant's initial brief pursuant to Rule 211 of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. Failure of Appellant to comply may result in the dismissal of this appeal.

Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant must also serve and file the supplemental record on appeal containing (1) Appellant's eight sentencing sheets; (2) the Conviction Summary from SCDC's Offender Management System; and (3) the Inmate Offense History from SCDC's Offender Management System.
