
FIRST REASON IS THAT MY SENTENCE IS ILLEGAL,

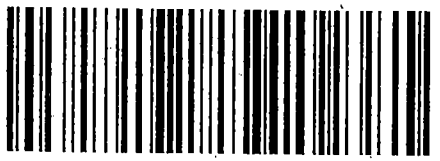
