Mr. Timmons,

I have received your letter dated May 29th, 2018 requesting the same transcript from your February letter. As I mentioned in that first letter, this firm requires a deposit before starting any work on the transcript. Once a deposit of \$250.00 is received, we will begin work. The transcript will be ready within a couple of weeks, at which time payment in full will be due before the transcript is released.


Again, no work on the transcript will begin until the deposit is received.
