TO THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF SOUTH CAROLINA AND ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

Appellant Lisa Fisher hereby objects to the continued informal contact of Respondents with this Court. Appellant has repeatedly objected to the actions of Respondents' counsel Jessica L. Crowley and W. Westbrook Wills in contacting Judges in the Circuit Court and the Probate Court and asking for instructions and assistance without statutory authority. However, they continue, and for that reason Appellant files these formal objections.

Said actions by Respondents are to garner favor with the Judges directly and to cast a false light on Appellants in this action. This prejudices Appellants and lacks the necessary procedural formalities which safeguard and protect all litigants.

Appellant Lisa Fisher previously filed a motion seeking to clarify the order re delivery of bonds, which this Court failed to consider, as it was deemed a Petition for Rehearing. Therefore, in reviewing the order of June 13, 2018, and the prior orders demanding deposit of the "monetary" assets with the Circuit Court. Appellant Lisa Fisher had to determine what to do with Bonds.

Review of the law governing savings bonds under 31 U.S. Code § 3105 and 31 CFR Part 315 et seq., Appellant Lisa Fisher determined that to comply with the orders of this Court, these bonds would have to be deposited with the Circuit Court. Since this Court ordered these assets

to remain in the Circuit Court, release of the bonds to Respondent would allow the 109 bonds to be immediately paid and make the court's orders of no effect in protecting the "cash" assets.

As evidenced by the Notice of Deposit attached hereto as Exhibit A and being sent for filing concurrently, she has deposited all bonds in her possession with the Circuit Court. Unfortunately, complying with the court order regarding the house took more time than anticipated, because of the informal method of transfer and false allegations by Respondents.

Appellant has complied with all orders, retaining only photographs and documents necessary for retrial, in the event that the Supreme Court grants a retrial. Without these original documents, Appellants will be prejudiced. At the hearing on the Motion for new trial, it was discovered that Respondents have illegally obtained journals belonging to Appellant Lisa Fisher. Appellants have long complained about illegal behavior and misconduct including conflicts of interests of Counsel Jessica Crowley (who now runs the Law Offices of Peter Kouten as evidenced by the signage before their office). These conflicts run afoul of legal standards relating to non-waiveable conflicts of interests.

Appellant raises this issue to demonstrate the problems necessitating extra protections in delivery of the bonds, personal property and papers in this case. Appellant substantially complied with the court's order of June 13, 2018. With the deposit of the orders and the delivery via Fed ex (to ensure tracking of the property), Appellant has fully complied.

Appellant respectfully requests that this Court consider the issues raised in this Objection.







ORDER






Appellants have filed a petition for a writ of supersedeas. Respondents have filed a return. The petition is denied.

We lift the temporary stays issued by this Court on May 24, 2018, and June 1, 2018, which stayed all orders and proceedings in all cases related to the estate of Alice Shaw-Baker. However, because the circuit court issued an order on May 29, 2018, in contravention of our May 24 temporary stay, we vacate the circuit court's May 29 order in case number 2009-CP-10-03010.

All real and personal property belonging to Shaw-Baker's estate, except funds held by the Charleston County Clerk of Court, shall be delivered to the personal representative, Bessie Huckabee, within seven days of the date of this order. The Charleston County Clerk of Court will retain possession of all cash assets, belonging to the estate pending the appeal and further order of this Court.

We grant appellants' motion to expedite this appeal to the extent that once all relevant transcripts are received, the parties will notify this Court, at which point an expedited briefing schedule will be set.
