The Court is in receipt of your correspondence filed June 25, 2018, which we construe as a notice of appeal. Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- An amended notice of appeal must be served and filed pursuant to Rule 203 and 267, SCACR. The amended notice of appeal must be headed by a caption. The caption must contain the name of the appellate court where the document is to be filed, the lower court case information, the county and judge, including the title of the judge, the title of the case which clearly states whom is the appellant and the respondent, and the title of the document.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve the notice of appeal on all respondents and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
