My former PCR attorney Mr Nathan Sheldon, has provided me with a copy of the Court's June 11 2018 correspondence to him in regard to the above referenced.

I notice in Mr Sheldon's "Notice of Appeal" filed/dated May 29 2018 he states erroneously that I wish to appeal the PCR Courts decision... Granting the review of his case Pursuant to White v State 263 SCD 108 SE 2d 35 (1974). This aspect of the PCR Court/Judges decision is incorrect.

By and with this correspondence I wish to make clear to the Court the following as my avenue of pursuit seeking relief; which I thought I clearly and concisely explained to Mr. Sheldon:

1. I do wish to have and participate in the belated appeal review granted by the PCR Judge the Honorable Roger E. Henderson April 21 2018 and not appeal this aspect of his decision granting such.
2. I do desire to appeal and have addressed the issue/matter of the PCR Judge's /Court's dismissal of my CDV claim presented as I was represented by the same two (2) plea attorneys who led me to the understanding the two (2) indictments and charges against me would be sentenced as combined in to one (1) sentence of both convictions and did not inform me of the direct consequences which would (and did) result in doing so, (loss of parole eligibility, sentence served as 85% violent rather than 61% non violent, etc.).
