After reviewing the appealability memoranda submitted by the parties, this appeal shall proceed because the underlying order is immediately appealable. *See Link v. School District of Pickens County*, 302 S.C. 1, 393 S.E.2d 176 (1990) (providing the grant of a partial summary judgment is immediately appealable).

Appellant's motion to stay this appeal and for a partial remand to the circuit court to consider the motion to compel settlement is granted. This appeal shall be held in abeyance for sixty days for the circuit court to resolve the motion. Appellant shall provide this court with a status update when the circuit court resolves the motion or upon the expiration of sixty days.
