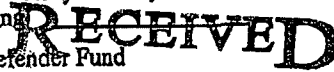

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on February 6, 2017, the Grand Jurors of Bamberg County present upon their oath:

That **KWAMAINE JARELLE ROSS** did in Bamberg County on or about October 24, 2015, feloniously, wilfully and with malice aforethought, murder Travis Anderson by means of shooting him, and that the victim did die in Bamberg County at 253 Sanders Street, Bamberg, South Carolina as a proximate result thereof on October 24, 2015. All in violation of Section 16-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976), as amended.
