Rodney Green in the Court of Appeals on May 24, 2018. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Michael Tompai in the Supreme Court on May 21, 2018. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Johnny Lee Burton in the Court of Appeals on May 16, 2018. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and Record on Appeal in the case of State v. Naijuwan Chisolm in the Court of Appeals on May 14, 2018. 


