NO EXHIBITS WERE INTRODUCED

1 (Whereupon, the following proceeding was held on
2 September 18, 2017, beginning at 4:14 PM.)

3 **PROBATION AGENT:** May it please the Court?

4 **THE COURT:** Yes, sir.

5 **PROBATION AGENT:** I believe you have a packet up
6 there. We're gonna do Gregory Dash.

7 **THE COURT:** Okay.

8 (Whereupon, Gregory O. Dash was duly sworn by the
9 Clerk of Court.)

10 **THE COURT:** Okay. Yes.

11 **PROBATION AGENT:** Your Honor, we have Mr. Gregory
12 Dash, who was convicted for criminal domestic violence,
13 second offense, and legal custodian unlawful negligent of
14 a child or a helpless person, in General Sessions court
15 in Orangeburg. The case number was 2015 General Sessions
16 30 -- correction, 38-00745, and 2015 General Sessions
17 38-00746, and that was 21 March 2016.

18 **THE COURT:** Okay.

19 **PROBATION AGENT:** He was sentenced to six years,
20 suspended to ninety days and two years probation by you,
21 Your Honor, and probation was to begin by 21 -- to begin
22 21 March 2016 and end 20 March 2018. As special
23 conditions, he was to attend criminal domestic counseling
24 through CASA and may not live with the victim until
25 treatment completed. He was to do parenting classes, he

1 was to go to voc rehab, substance abuse counseling and
2 random drug and alcohol screening.

3 His case was heard one time prior on March the 15th,
4 2017, by the Honorable -- I mean, by Hearing Officer B.J.
5 Sumter on which he -- it was ordered that he continue
6 probation as provided for the original sentence. The
7 subject was to -- he was to -- subject to conditions set
8 forth therein and not inconsistent with this -- this
9 order.. He was to satisfy the Department's fees and
10 arrearage and a civil judgment for fines and other fees.
11 Additional conditions ordered by the Court was for him to
12 pay his supervision arrearage account within ninety days
13 and enroll and complete the substance abuse counseling
14 and CDV classes. He didn't do either. Mr. Dash, what he
15 did, was after that -- after that hearing he absconded
16 from supervision.

17 **THE COURT:** Okay. Thank you.

18 All right. Yes, sir.

19 **MR. BANKS:** Your Honor, this is one of those age old
20 situations of limited opportunity, having to -- in fact,
21 some of the restrictions like where he had to live and
22 couldn't be back with his family and all that stuff put
23 some additional financial responsibility on him and so my
24 client, he served a ninety-day shock originally on the
25 original charge. That's that ninety days that he got.

1 But this put him in a position to having to really
2 expand out to try to find a job and he did find one. He
3 actually found a very good job with Mars Pet Food, but in
4 Blythewood, and as you know that's at least an hour from
5 here and in that situation he even found a ride. Well,
6 the ride was -- I don't know if you've ever had much to
7 do with these rural kind of give me a ride things, but
8 you end up paying these people a lot of money for these
9 rides, so he gets -- he even arranged that.

10 At the same time he got behind because of his other
11 troubles, so he's on child support, so his check gets
12 garnished at Mars, so he's being garnished, a good job,
13 then he had some medical problems where he had -- his teeth
14 are hurting and he has to get root canals and all that and
15 he's got about a 5,000 dollar medical bill and the dentist
16 doesn't -- it's not like you go to the emergency room for
17 that and the dentist, he had to pay these -- lots of money
18 up front and still owes them.

19 He -- when he went to work at Mars, he had a -- they
20 put him on a six-month probation and part of that probation
21 -- I know you know this -- that if you miss a day or you're
22 late, you know, there's points and then you're out, you
23 know. I mean, it's very strict, especially this place
24 because of how good a position it was, and so he was on
25 this strict probation which he had to get to Blythewood

1 every day and that's one of the reasons he was not able to
2 come to his appointments with Agent Wright. He's been in
3 jail since August the 28th on this bench warrant and it's
4 just one of those age old situations where opportunity is
5 limited, the job is so far away from this rural community,
6 and he's -- like I said, he's got -- he's still got issues.

7 I guess I would ask in this situation, having talked
8 to him, I don't -- I can't say that a full revocation is in
9 order. I realize it's not the best case either, but giving
10 him credit for time served I'd ask that you limit any
11 revocation to six months.

12 **THE COURT:** Okay. Anything further from Probation?

13 **PROBATION AGENT:** Yes, ma'am.

14 **THE COURT:** All right. I'm listening.

15 **PROBATION AGENT:** After all Mr. Banks has said, this
16 is not his first time. He's been on probation before and
17 the last time he was on probation he did the same thing.
18 He didn't give probation -- he didn't give probation the
19 opportunity to help him this time. He talked about his
20 teeth. Voc rehab would take care of it, but he didn't give
21 probation that opportunity to help him. And, again, that
22 is his history. He does that, he'll run off. And we have
23 a victim here.

24 **THE COURT:** Yes.

25 **VICTIM ADVOCATE:** Hi. This is Ms. Spigner. She's a

1 little nervous.

2 **THE COURT:** I'll be happy to hear from you.

3 **THE VICTIM:** My name's Lakendra Spigner.

4 **THE COURT:** And can you spell your first and last name
5 for my court reporter?

6 **THE VICTIM:** It's L-A-K-E-N-D-R-A, Lakendra. Last
7 name is S-P-I-G-N-E-R.

8 **THE COURT:** Okay. I'm listening. Tell me what you
9 want me to know.

10 **THE VICTIM:** I'm kind of like nervous to speak. Me
11 and Mr. Dash has been involved for ten years and throughout
12 the whole ten years I've experienced nothing but physical,
13 mental and emotional abuse from him and I'm just nervous
14 to speak because I'm tired of kind of like reflecting on
15 everything that I've been through. I'm trying to push
16 forward and move forward with my life.

17 **THE COURT:** Is he leaving you alone?

18 **THE VICTIM:** Can you state that again?

19 **THE COURT:** Is he leaving you alone?

20 **THE VICTIM:** No.

21 **THE COURT:** Okay.

22 **THE VICTIM:** He'll tell me that he will change, I'll
23 believe it and be foolish and get back to square one. He
24 needs to see his kids and I go for it because my dad's a
25 veteran and I've had my dad all my life, so not to have

1 my kids' father involved, you know, with my children,
2 that's unknown to me. I don't know how that feels. So,
3 of course, I would want the same thing for my children, so
4 here, again, I'm accepting and believing what he's saying
5 and it results back to this same outcome.

6 **THE COURT:** Okay.

7 **THE VICTIM:** And even about the child support
8 situation, and Mr. Hastie is sitting right there, we just
9 started last month with child support, so I can't really
10 say I've been receiving anything. It just started as an
11 open case.

12 **THE COURT:** I'm with you. Thank you for being here.
13 I appreciate it.

14 **THE VICTIM:** Yes, ma'am.

15 **THE COURT:** Yes. Anything else?

16 **MR. BANKS:** Your Honor, my client tells me that the
17 only communications they have are involving visitation of
18 the children.

19 **THE COURT:** Okay. Okay. Uh-huh.

20 **THE DEFENDANT:** I just wanted to state for the record,
21 Your Honor, that the new case is actually a new case. I
22 haven't actually been on child support prior to this whole
23 incident.

24 **THE COURT:** She said that. She said she just started
25 like last month with the whole process to try to get you to

1 pay some child support.

2 **THE DEFENDANT:** Yeah, like I said, it's a new case and
3 whatnot.

4 **THE COURT:** Yeah, she said that.

5 **THE DEFENDANT:** In fact, you know, the relationship
6 issues really has not -- like I say, it really has nothing
7 to really do with my probation. It's just -- it's just
8 been a whole lot of misunderstandings and things that's
9 been going on between us for over a year. Actually my
10 probation officer knows about some of the things that have
11 taken place as far as things that have transpired between
12 me and the mother of my kids and it's just been a whole
13 lot of mixups and things that -- you know, childish -- let
14 me put it like that -- childish ways between adults who
15 should be acting like grown folks who have kids and I just
16 wanted to state that.

17 Like I said, I've just been going through a whole lot
18 of things. As far as my prior record of me getting a
19 possession with intent to distribute at age seventeen has
20 actually jeopardized me from getting a whole lot of jobs
21 and made my financial ability very low and my job rates
22 very low. A lot of jobs turn me down because of the fact
23 of my prior history and it's very hard for me to get a job
24 and when I finally got one I was just trying to keep it.

25 **THE COURT:** I'm with you. I'm with you.

1 Okay. Anything further?

2 **MR. BANKS:** No.

3 **THE COURT:** Okay. When I -- when I issue sentences,
4 Mr. Dash, I don't do it just to hear myself speak.

5 **THE DEFENDANT:** Yes, ma'am.

6 **THE COURT:** I mean it. I told you to stay away from
7 her until there was time for you to finish your counseling
8 for abuse. This wasn't your first rodeo. Do you
9 understand? I don't just -- I don't -- I don't enter
10 sentences just to hear myself talk. I'm revoking your
11 probation. Thank you, sir.

12 All right.

13 **PROBATION AGENT:** In full, ma'am?

14 **THE COURT:** Yes. And with regards to the monies he
15 owes, a civil judgment, and he is certainly entitled to all
16 the credit for the time that he has served. I'm revoking
17 both, all of it, and terminate.

18 **PROBATION AGENT:** Okay.




Mr. Dash has absconded from supervision. His whereabouts as of the date of this affidavit is unknown;


Mr. Dash failed to pay his probation Supervision Fees by being six (6) payments or \$300.00 in arrears as of 3 Aug 2017;
