COMMON PLEAS AND  
GENERAL SESSIONS

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This case was before the Court, on the captioned indictments and heard by the undersigned Circuit Court Judge for the State of South Carolina presiding.

A trial by jury was called and held on June 18, 2018 and June 19, 2018. The jury found the Defendant guilty on all three indictments.

However, prior to the trial of this case, the Defendant filed his complaint in the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina, Anderson Division alleging violation of Defendant's Civil Rights under 42 USC §183. The complaint filed in the United States District Court allegedly arose from the same events set forth in the State's indictments against Defendant.

At the time and on the date of Defendant's convictions in the Tenth Judicial Circuit on the State's indictments, the allegations of 42 USC §1983, violation of Defendant's Civil Rights under 42 USC§1983 had not been resolved.

Therefore, this court has deferred sentence on the State jury's finding of guilty of the captioned indictments pending resolution of the Defendant's complaint filed in Federal Court.

As set forth under "other" conditions on the sentencing sheet attached hereto the Defendant shall be released on the \$50,000.00 bond approved by Judge S. Thompson Tucker on January 25, 2017 and made a part of this order, with the following additional conditions:

1. The Defendant is on house arrest at \_\_\_\_\_ Anderson, South Carolina 29625 until further order of this court.
2. He shall not leave this residence for any reason except to travel to and from work and during work hours, or to attend court proceedings, or to counsel with his attorney, or for family medical emergencies. Defendant shall be subject to electronic

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monitoring through Eagle Eye Monitoring and shall be subject to all directions under Eagle Eye Monitoring Services.

3. Defendant shall not leave Anderson County and shall be under curfew seven (7) days a week from 7:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.
4. While on electronic monitoring, Sr. Assistant Solicitor, Kristin Reeves of the Anderson County Solicitor's Office and Defense Counsel, Charles W. Whiten, Jr. shall confer on a monthly basis beginning July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018 and continuing thereafter, as to the status of Defendant's Federal complaint and shall jointly file a short synopsis of continuing events in the Federal Court with the Clerk of Court of Anderson County, said synopsis to be filed with the Clerk and attached to the bond on file there. The court reserves the right to alter the provisions of this order at any time including addition of conditions of the bond and sentencing of the Defendant.

5. Defendant consented to this Court amend the conditions of his Bond

6. Any violation of Bond, electronic monitoring or Probation shall subject Defendant to immediate sentencing by the undersigned
