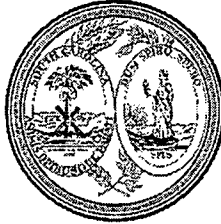

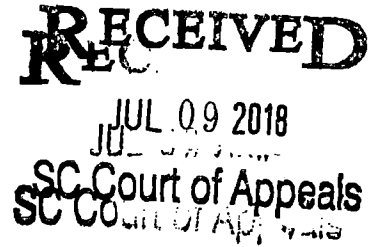

Dear Ms. Kitchings:

The Department is in receipt of the Court's letter dated June 26, 2018. In response to said letter, the USB drive filed along with the Record on Appeal contains two (2) exhibits offered by the Respondent and admitted by the Administrative Law Court (ALC) during the hearing held on November 2, 2017. These items are listed on the Index for the Record on Appeal as Respondent's Exhibit No. 2 and Respondent's Exhibit No. 5.

Specifically, the Respondent offered and the ALC admitted Respondent's Exhibit 2, which is a visual presentation of Bi-Lo's cash register training on age-restricted items. The Respondent also offered and the ALC admitted Respondent's Exhibit 5, which is a video of Dawn Staley, the coach of the University of South Carolina's women's basketball team, promoting Bi-Lo.
