MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Kashaun Banks respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until August 8, 2018**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Kashaun Banks respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. 

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of John Edward Hunsucker v. The State with the Supreme Court on June 5, 2018. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of Robert Henry Osbey v. The State with the Supreme Court on May 31, 2018. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Jimmy Larry Gilstrap with the Court of Appeals on May 30, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and the accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Justin Jermaine Johnson with the Supreme Court on May 23, 2018. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Antwan J. Jett with the Court of Appeals on May 4, 2018.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


