Defendant seeks pre-trial detention credit on his sentence for the time he was on home detention prior to sentencing. The court denied credit for time spent on home detention.

Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976 §24-13-40 provides, in pertinent part, that "full credit against the sentence must be given for time served prior to trial and sentencing, and may be given for any time spent under monitored house arrest." (emphasis added). Therefore, pre-trial detention credit for home detention is discretionary with the court.

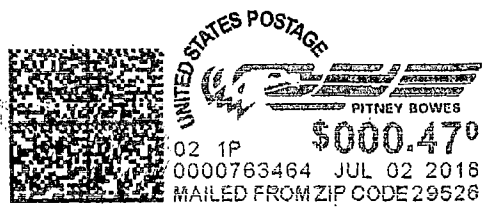
