Dear Mr. Crosby:

Upon reviewing your correspondence filed on June 9, 2018, which this Court construes as an attempt to file a notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The notice of appeal fails to include a statement of when you received written notice of entry of the order or judgment from which this appeal is taken.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- A proof of service showing that a copy has been timely served on the agency and/or the Administrative Law Court has not been provided as required by Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR.
- The notice of appeal must comply in form and content with Rule 203 of the SCACR. No argument is allowed in the notice of appeal.

- You must serve and file an amended notice of appeal substantially in the format shown by Form 6 in Appendix C to Part II of the SCACR within ten (10) days of the date of this letter.
