1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Dayvonn A. Valentine v. State in the Supreme Court on December 17, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of James Alexander v. State with the Supreme Court on December 12, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Ashante Wright v. State with the Supreme Court on December 12, 2012. Counsel filed the reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari in this Court in Darrell Goss v. State on December 4,

2012. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in State v. Paris Avery with the Supreme Court on November 26, 2012. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Douglas Thompson v. State were filed and served with the Supreme Court on November 21, 2012. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Charles Ray Dean v. State was filed in the Supreme Court on November 15, 2012. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter with this Court in State v. Michael Couch on November 7, 2012.


