

MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Attorney for Appellant, Manuel Antonio Marin, hereby requests a 30-day extension of time for ordering the transcript from the PCR Hearing for the following reasons:

1. Appellant is indigent having been incarcerated in SCDC continuously since 2008;
2. Appellant's attorney was hired by Appellant's sister using her personal funds;
3. Attorney has sent Appellant an Affidavit of Indigency to complete so that he can be represented by the Commission of Appellate Defense on his PCR appeal;


