ORDER

This court denied Appellant's petition to reinstate on March 22, 2018, and sent down the remittitur on April 27, 2018. Appellant has now filed a letter, which this court construes as a request that this court recall the remittitur and reinstate the appeal. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Appellant has failed to make such a showing. Appellant's motion, therefore, is denied.
