I received your letter dated July 17, 2018 requiring I advise the Court of the status of the requested transcript in this case within ten days. On February 10, 2017, I filed a Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and appendix with the Supreme Court. Mr. Coley filed a *pro se* motion to supplement the appendix with the Supreme Court on March 24, 2017 and his *pro se* response on April 24, 2017. Before ruling on the motion to supplement the appendix, the Supreme Court transferred this case to this Court pursuant to Rule 243(l), SCACR.


On February 15, 2018, this Court granted Mr. Coley's *pro se* motion to supplement the appendix with the documents marked as Court's Exhibit No. 1 during his guilty plea hearing and with the transcript of the hearing on his motion for reconsideration held on June 18, 2015. My office requested and received a copy of Court's Exhibit No. 1 from the Richland County Clerk of Court in March. On March 20, 2018, we also requested a copy of the June 18, 2015 hearing transcript from the court reporter since this transcript had never been transcribed.

By notice dated July 11, 2018, Court Administration granted the court reporter an extension until July 21, 2018 to prepare and deliver this transcript.

I received an electronic copy of the transcript on Monday, July 16, 2018. In her correspondence, the court reporter indicated she would mail the signed certificate page that day. I had hoped to receive the signed certificate page this week so that I could file the supplemental appendix immediately. However, as of the writing of this letter, I have not received the signed certificate page. I will file the supplemental appendix as soon as I receive this document.

I hope this letter clarifies the status of this appeal and the requested transcript. If the Court requires any additional information, please contact me.
