**OBJECTION TO APPEALS COURT'S ORDER IMPOSING
UNREASONABLE CONDITIONS TO ACCESS THE COURT**

Even though provided by the rules, the appellant objects to this court order denying her request for a variance of the rules imposing unreasonable conditions for her access to the appeals court.

The paperwork required by the rules has created an unreasonable burden upon the appellant and has imposed impossible costs and this appeals court has refused to hear the appeal on its merits unless the appellant suffers through all of these costs and burdens. Namely, the appeals brief requires a blue cover and the record in a white cover. The 68 pages record totaling 1,124 pages was mailed and filed April 30th, 2018 in white booklet form. The required binder's or folders are \$3.49 each, plus the printing at Staples or Office Max and are not sold in large quantities so they are not readily available without special orders. And because the appellant is not an attorney and does not have access to such suppliers, these requirements

penalize her simply because she is not an attorney and not represented by an attorney.

Walmart has some cheap ones but not enough in stock for what is required in the record. This would require 36 binder/folders, at least costing \$125 without printing cost and binding each page. Even if the appellant could afford this one expense, there is not enough supply that is reasonably within her ability to obtain.

Furthermore, the special type of paper, such as 50 or 60 lb. Is costly and not readily available to the appellant. The costs for printing on this paper are at least 15 cents a page.

The costs are insurmountable and supplies are not readily available simply because the appellant is not an attorney who is in the business of needing to stock these types of supplies.

Modern technology, computers and software, allow the court to avoid having to use paper in this matter. Why isn't the court using modern technology when it is far more available than colored and special paper and binding materials.

While the appellant will continue to make her best effort to comply with the rules, the appellant objects to this court's unfair imposition of the rules and denying the appellant access to the court simply because she cannot afford to prepare the brief under the rules and does not have access to the supplies required to complete the brief as requested by the rules. The Supreme Court never had in mind to deny anyone access to the court simply for these reasons and the court is inclined to hear cases on their merits.




